Evaluation

Summary of the course evaluation

Number of survey responses: 6, of which is 19% of the students

Short summary of the evaluation responses: The level of response to this survey was very poor, and I think this was a function of the distance learning delivery of the course (thus not having a physical meeting where it was possible to emphasize the importance of completing the survey). Similarly, very few students showed up to a Zoom meeting for interactive feedback. Given the incredibly small sample, I am reluctant to interpret the results too closely ... as this is really a very small proportion of course participants.

Comments from the teaching team

Not much was reported that distinguished HT20 from previous iterations of the course. Obviously, delivering it by distance learning was a significant change, but we seemed to be fairly successful in delivering a similar learning experience.

Evaluation of changes implemented since the last time the course was given The move to using ArcGIS Pro for the programming component of the course was largely successful, with no major problems having been reported.

Suggestions for changes to implement before the course is given the next time Given the state of things (the continuing Covid-19 pandemic) having us maintaining a distance learning approach on this campus course, we will likely run it in ht21 as we did in ht20.
