Evaluation

Summary of the course evaluation

Number of survey responses: 13, of which is 61 % of the students

Short summary of the evaluation responses: In general the students were very satisfied with the course (overall score of 3.4, on a scale 0-5). The score is relatively less than previous years which is mainly related to distance education introduced this year because of COBID-19. The students thought the course aim was reached and that practical exercises were interesting and instructive. The individual project in the course was however too much work and should have more time in the schedule. In general it is a course that requires a high workload in both understanding the theories and the practical methodologies.

Comments from the teaching team

Teachers' opinion is that the course went very well. A good mix of students from different and a pleasant number to teach. The students showed great interest in the subjects taught.

Evaluation of changes implemented since the last time the course was given All lectures were recorded as video lectures. We also received comments about the revision of the course we made in 2019. The comments will be used to further improve the course for 2021.
