Summary of the course evaluation

In general the students that finished the course were satisfied with the course and the fulfilment of the course aims (overall score of 4.1 and 4.3, on a scale 1-5). Some students found the course content and workload to be high in relation to the ECTS credits (3.8, on a scale 1-5).

The teachers provided motivation and inspiration (score 3.9), as well as useful feedback (score 4.1), and the practical arrangement of the course scored 4.1.

Comments from the teaching team

In comparison with 2020, 2021 scored slightly higher.







Did you get enough training in written communication? (1=No, not at all, 5= Yes, completely)







